This workshop is designed for educators who are interested in using the free SAS Viya for Learners (VFL) platform for teaching and learning data science and analytics concepts. You will learn how to (i) gain access to VFL, (ii) set-up a class, (iii) manage student registrations, (iv) access course materials, (v) explore available datasets, and (vi) navigate the VFL interface. Demonstrations will guide users through accessing and exploring data with SAS Visual Analytics, building models with SAS Visual Statistics, building and comparing models with Model Studio, and publishing and managing models and scoring new data with SAS Model Manager. The workshop will also include a brief overview of free resources delivered by the SAS Academic Programs team including software, teaching materials, on-site workshops, and elearning. The mission of SAS Academic Programs is to enable faculty to deliver SAS tools in the classroom and train students so that we can make talent connections with students and our customers who have analytics hiring needs.
